The City of Lincoln's Parking Services Division wants to save you time, money and energy; so we created the i-Park card. It's a fast and convenient way to park downtown.

What is the *i-Park* card?

It is a prepaid value card used each time you enter and exit the parking facilities. It eliminates the need for cash and check payments, as well as speeds up the time it takes to exit the garage.

Where can I get an *i-Park* card?

You can pick up your i-Park card at the City of Lincoln Parking Office.

How do I use my *i-Park* card?

Swipe your card when you enter and exit a garage. After you exit, the time spent in the garage is calculated, and the appropriate fee is deducted from your balance.

How much does an *i-Park* card cost?

i-Park participants receive a 20% bonus value on parking. The available increments and the discounted rate are listed below.

Parking Value	Your Cost
\$36	\$30
\$72	\$60
\$108	\$90

Can I add more value to the card?

Yes, simply return to the parkandgo.org website and load more money to your card or visit our main office at 1100 "N" Street.

Where can I use the *i-Park* card?

Cards are valid, and regular rates apply at all city parking facilities:

Blue 3 535 "P" Street

Carriage Park 11th & "L" streets

Center Park 11th & "N" streets

Cornhusker 12th & "L" streets

Eagle 14th & "N" streets

Green 2 530 "P" Street

Haymarket 9th & "Q" streets

Participants will have access to these facilities 24/7 with subject to availability and special events.

What do I do when my card balance is low?

You can use your card until it has a \$0 balance. Simply reload your card at parkandgo.org. If not reloading your card, take a ticket and pay the regular daily rate.

Will these cards work on Husker Football game days or special events?

Validated or discounted parking is not allowed on Husker Football game days or special events.

What if I lose my *i-Park* card?

If your card is lost or damaged, a new one can be issued at the City of Lincoln Parking Office. NOTE: Please keep cards away from magnets or magnetic surfaces, such as cellphones or credit cards.

Can I be refunded for parking I do not use?

No refunds will be issued for any unused value on your i-Park card.
