

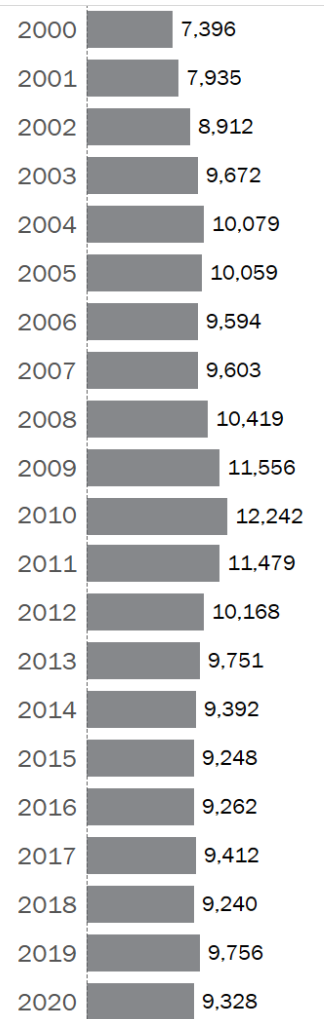

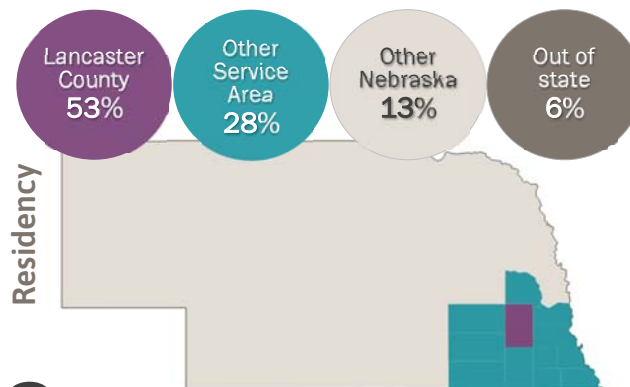
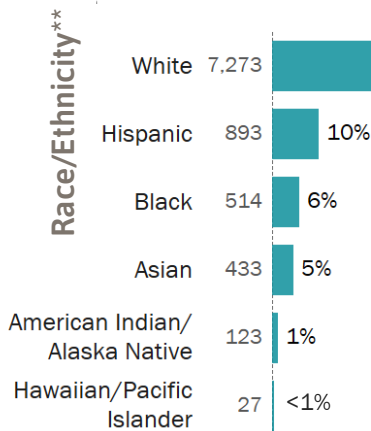
Credit Enrollment, Fall 2021

[^] Credit Enrollment charts are based on enrollment at the term census date; 9302 students were enrolled on that date for the Fall 2021 term.

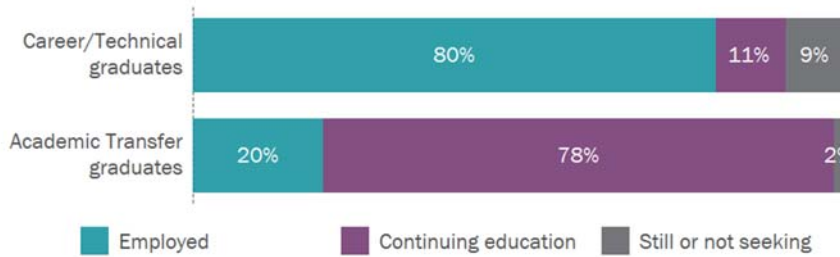

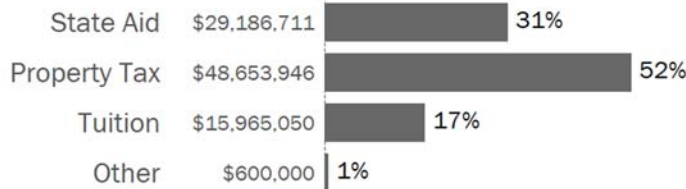
Of the **1215** students who graduated in 2020:

1097 were in Career/Technical fields **120** were in Academic Transfer

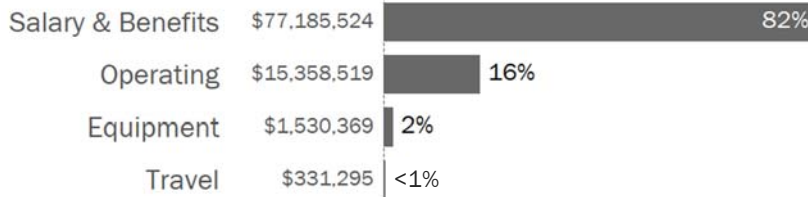
Most Career/Technical graduates are employed, while most Academic Transfer graduates are continuing their education.
