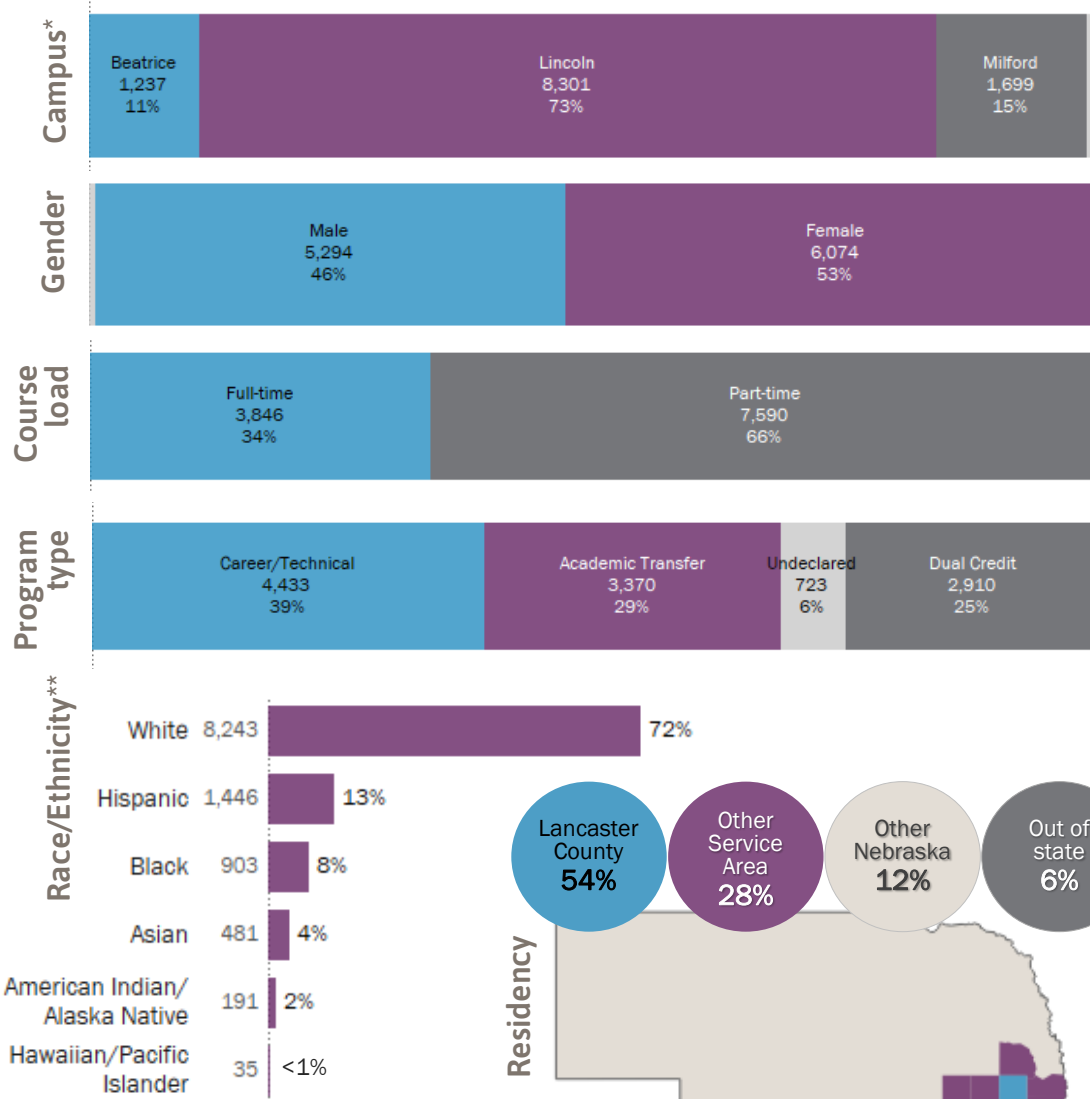

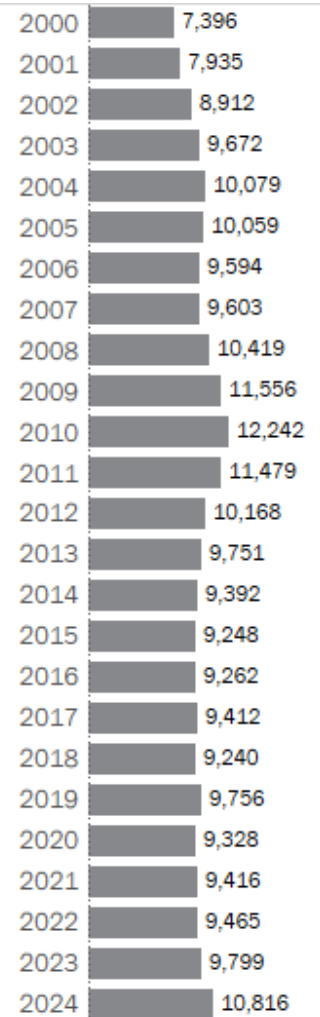

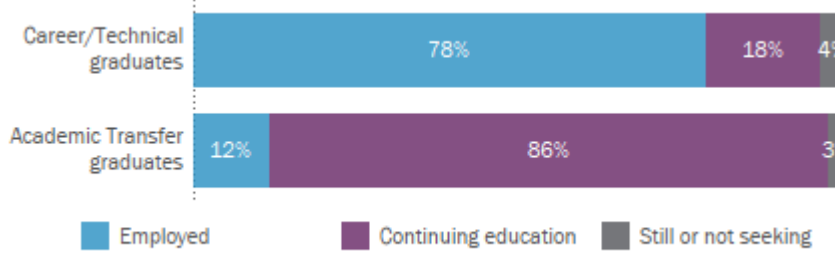


Of the **1238** students who graduated in 2024:

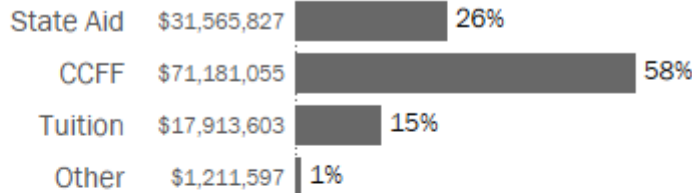
**1042** were in Career/Technical fields

**200** were in Academic Transfer

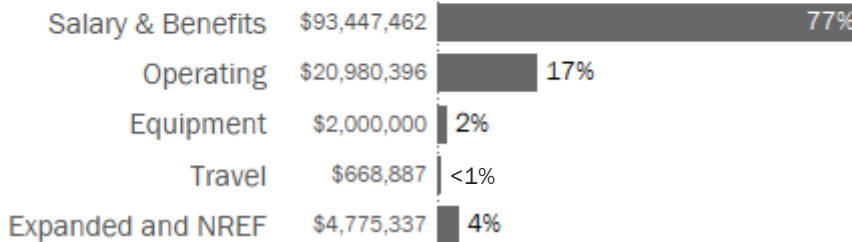
Most Career/Technical graduates are employed, while most Academic Transfer graduates are continuing their education.
