


Mission


Credit enrollment in Fall 2025 was **11,436**




Of the **1238** students who graduated in 2024:

1042 were in Career/Technical fields **200** were in Academic Transfer


Most Career/Technical graduates are employed, while most Academic Transfer graduates are continuing their education.
