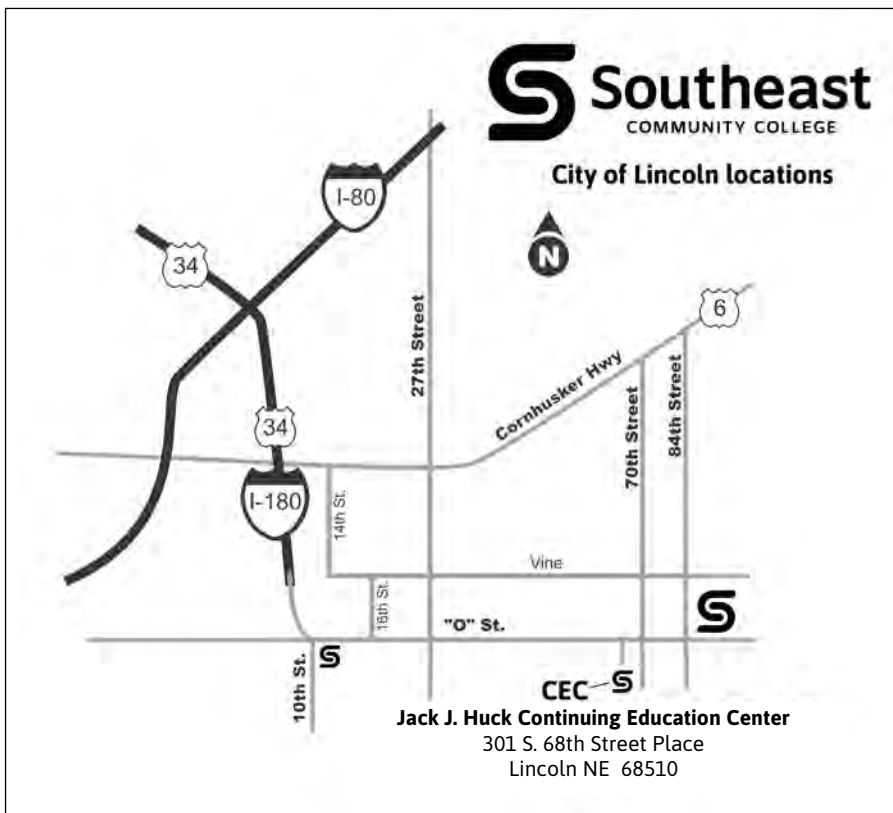
What to Bring
