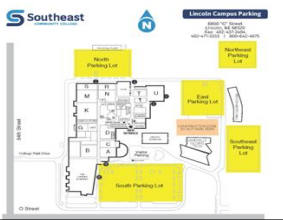

LINCOLN CAMPUS PARKING UPDATE

The Lincoln Campus will implement a parking warning/ticket process that will begin on Monday, November 13th. The Safety/Security team will be making routine checks throughout the day and evening. Vehicle that is illegally parked in an area that is not a designated parking lot will receive a nice warning, with a map showing you where to find the designated parking lots, to inform you that you are in a no parking area. If your vehicle is cited a second time, you will receive a written warning of a parking violation. If your vehicle is cited a third time, a parking violation ticket will be issued. Parking ticket fines must be paid prior to the deadline stated on the ticket and are payable at the Cashier's Office. Failure to pay fines according to campus rules and regulations will result in an initiation of a Student Code of Conduct review.
