

Installing LockDown Browser for Chromebook


Navigate to the Canvas course quiz that requires Respondus <u>LockDown</u> Browser, and click the button to take the quiz.




## You should receive this screen if the Respondus <u>LockDown</u> Browser extension is not installed. Click the [Download Respondus <u>LockDown</u> Browser] link




## Click "Add extension" on the Add "LockDown Browser"? Pop up






## Using LockDown Browser for Chromebook


Open the Chrome browser and navigate to course in Canvas. Click the button to take the quiz. A screen should display that it's opening Respondus LockDown Browser



Once inside the Quiz, you should see a gray bar across the top of the screen, with <u>LockDown</u> Browser and a padlock icon in the upper-right corner. You are now in Respondus <u>LockDown</u> Browser for Chromebook



After submitting the final question, you should be taken back to the Quiz screen in Canvas. You will need to click the X icon in the gray bar to exit LockDown Browser
